

Required Business Account Documentation

Sole Proprietorship:

- <u>Filed</u> Fictitious Firm Name Filing (good for 5 years)
- Two forms of identification for each signer

Corporation:

- Filed Articles of Incorporation
- List of Corporate Officers pulled from SOS
- <u>Filed</u> Fictitious Firm Name Filing (if applicable)
- Two forms of identification for each signer

Limited Liability Company:

- Filed Articles of Organization
- Operating Agreement (if they do not have one because they are a sole owner then they have to put that in writing and state that they don't have one and they need to date and sign the letter)
- List of Officers/Members pulled from SOS
 - 1. Review the Members that are on record with the SOS.
 - 2. If the Members are other LLC's, Corporations or Trusts you have to investigate until you know who the real owner is (eventually it will be a person or people.
 - **3.** If the member is a Trust get a copy of the Trust Agreement showing who the trustees are; if they aren't the people in front of you find out who they are.
 - 4. If the members are other LLC's or Corporations pull up their list of officers/members off of the SOS until you can identify who the real owner is (eventually it will be a person or people.
- <u>Filed</u> Fictitious Firm Name Filing (if applicable)
- Two forms of identification for each signer

General Partnership:

- Partnership Agreement
- Two forms of identification for each signer

Limited Partnership:

- Limited Partnership Agreement
- Two forms of identification for each signer

An Organization, Association, or Non-Profit Organization:

- Organization/Association Resolution or
- Organization/Association Bylaws
- Meeting Minutes
- List of Officers
- Two forms of identification for each signer

All individual signers must have the following things verified (CIP):

- Name
- DOB
- Address
- SSN
